Entry requirements

To be eligible to enter for the Concern Fast prizes you must:

- Not be a member of Concern Worldwide staff
- Have registered and fundraised for the 2017 Fast Campaign
- Must have all monies/funds raised to Concern by 22nd December 2017
- For schools: Be a school based in the Republic of Ireland
- For Individual fundraisers: Be resident in the Republic of Ireland

Prizes

Schools:
